# **Tournament Review—Troon North (Pinnacle)**

The SGL 2018-19 got off to a hot start on Saturday at Troon North's Pinnacle course. Not because of scores, mind you, but because of a 2:00 PM start in  $106^{\circ}$  heat. Thirty-five players took on the challenge and played to an average gross of 98.8 and average net of 79.9. Jeff Thursam occupied a familiar spot at the top with the low gross at 76, while Anthony Uribe had the day's best net at 65.

Despite the high scores, the birdie rate was about average for our group. There were 19 of them, by 15 players on 12 different holes. Jeff, Anthony, Dan Shumaker and Marc Caporrimo each posted a pair.

The most difficult hole proved to be the dead-into-the-sun long par-4 3<sup>rd</sup>, playing at an average of 2.06 strokes over par. The back nine par-3s, #s 13 and 16, tied for the easiest at +1.06.

Jeff was the season's first Flight 1 winner, with a net 70 to go with his 76. Anthony crushed it in Flight 2, putting up 81/65 and winning by 11 strokes. Ben Goodwin topped Flight 3 at 88/71 and Matt Leonard won Flight 4 with 94/66. Jared Nielsen led a five-player Men's Callaway group at 89/73, and Stephanie Davis won the Women's Callaway.

Jeff's birdie on the 5<sup>th</sup>, plus three leftovers at the end gave him the most Gross Skins for the day with 8. Mike Tobin staved off his nuclear meltdown long enough to make par/net eagle on the 7<sup>th</sup>, picking up 7 Net Skins.

Closest to the Pins went to Zack Gieszler on the 6<sup>th</sup>, Jeff on the 8<sup>th</sup>, Anthony on the 13<sup>th</sup> and Bob Owen on the 16<sup>th</sup>. The latter three of those were converted to Deuces. Anthony added another on the 8<sup>th</sup>, and Steve Neil, Elmer Schmidt, John Garner, Lee Steelgrave and Mike Hultquist also posted 2s.

Steve Neil and George Banach each used just 27 putts to lead that category.

Jeff piled up \$100 to lead twenty-two money winners.
