Our last two weeks have seen us on opposite sides of The Valley, first at Tuscany Falls in Goodyear, then Ocotillo in Chandler. Stat summaries are posted below. Here are some of the highlights:

- George Banach has a two-event winning streak going, taking the 3<sup>rd</sup> Flight at Tuscany Falls and the 2<sup>nd</sup> at Ocotillo
- · Rich Perry has won money in every way possible over the last two weeks and is rocketing up the season money list
- Tuscany Falls saw eight players shoot in the 70s
- For the first time in memory, the hardest hole at Ocotillo was not the Tin Cup #9 White, but rather #2 White
- · Both weeks saw a player win two CTPs—Gary Moffitt at Tuscany and Rich at Ocotillo

• We achieved a Pace of Play milestone at Ocotillo with the entire field beating the target time of 4 hours, 15 minutes, although it was apparently fueled by a badgering course marshal

This week finds us back at Wigwam, this time on the Blue course for the middle round of the Wigwam Warriors competition. Blue is the shortest of the three courses at 6,000 yards, but is also par-70, with six par-3s. Tee times begin at 8:00, and as of press time we have 8 openings.

WHS Now Up and Running at the AGA Site

The <u>AGA web site</u> is now available for score posting. If you are not already familiar with this, just go to the site, log in, click "Post A Score" and fill in the necessary information. It does not yet appear to have all of the plan functionality, which includes hole-by-hole posting, but should soon.

For the time being, you will still need to post your own SGL rounds in addition to your non-league rounds. They are working on an app which will eventually allow Dave to enter all league scores with a single click, and we will alert you when that's ready.

In the meantime, there is a mobile app that does have the hole-by-hole functionality ready to go, which will take the guesswork out of what you are able to post as a max score on a given hole. Go to your app store and search on "USGA GHIN", then download GHIN Mobile.
