

## Tournament Review—Golf Club of Estrella

Tom Hegna is burning like a bright orange fire. His 74 at Golf Club of Estrella was the low gross among 40 players, and his net 63 was also best. It's rare in our league for one player to claim both, and now Tom has pulled it off two weeks in a row. Well played, Orange Man!

Golf Club of Estrella was in remarkable condition for being one day out of overseed, and it provided a stiff challenge. Our average gross was 93.8, second highest only to Troon North, and average net was 75.0, also second highest.

We scored 23 birdies, scored by 14 different players on just 9 holes. JR Blaszek put up 5 of them, a season high for the league. The toughest hole was the par-5 16<sup>th</sup>, playing at an average of 1.85 strokes over par. There was a tie for easiest between the 1<sup>st</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>, both par-4s that played at +0.85.

CTPs were earned by JR Blaszek on the 3<sup>rd</sup> hole, Robert Czaplewski on the 7<sup>th</sup>, Gerry Owsiany on the 14<sup>th</sup> and Brian Gregory on the 17<sup>th</sup>.

JR's birdie binge paved the way to 11 Gross Skins, while net eagles on the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> holes earned 11 Net Skins for Brennan Murray.

The 17<sup>th</sup> was the only hole to yield Deuces on Saturday and there were three, posted by Tom, Brian and Kevin Gadowski.

Bo Montgomery led the way in Low Putts, needing only 26 to get around.

JR topped a list of twenty-three money winners with a total of \$92.

## Next Up—StoneRidge

This week we again venture north, this time to StoneRidge Golf Course in Prescott Valley. The course is considered quite challenging, with a slope rating of 132 from the Gold tees. This will be the league's first visit to this venue since 2011.

It will be COLD, with temperatures in the low 40s at best when we tee off in a shotgun start at 9:30. Plan accordingly.
