Forty-four SGLers took on the Champions course at the TPC Scottsdale last Saturday and put up a collectively solid round, with an average gross of 89.8. Kyle Rector was again the medalist with a 2-over 73, while Rich Perry shot a blistering net 62.

There were birdies galore—41 of them in total, posted by 25 different players on 14 holes. Dan Shumaker led the way with four of them. Jeff Coughran did not have a birdie, but he did have an eagle, scoring it on the par-5 10th hole.

The toughest hole proved to be the par-4 14th, playing to an average on 1.73 strokes over par. The easiest was the par-3 3rd at just +0.39.

Dan won Flight 1 with a 74 gross/70 net, while Dave Dean took Flight 2 at 76/66. In Flights 3 and 4, Jeff and Rich both won for the second week in a row, Jeff shooting 81/69 and Rich 86/62.

There were five CTP holes this week and your winners were Kyle on the 3rd hole, Dave on the 6th, John Sharland on the 8th, Derek Oldham on the 13th and John Wilhelm on the 16th.

Two of Dan's birdies were of the Deuce variety, and eight other players also got to write a 2 on their card.

Ken Slagle needed only 26 putts to get around, winning that category.

Dave topped a list of twenty-four money winners with \$73.
