

Tournament Recaps—Wigwam (Blue) and Los Caballeros

Our last two events were the opening round of Wigwam Warriors on the resort's Blue course, and the beautiful Los Caballeros course in Wickenburg. The statistical summaries are below. Here are some of the highlights:

- Wigwam saw a rare combination of three-way ties for both low gross and low net. In gross, Bo Montgomery, Dave Dean and Royal Clayton all posted 76. In net, Dave, Joe Pilewicz and Marc Caporrimo all had 66.
- Kevin Gadowski scored the season's 3rd eagle on Los Caballeros' downhill-and-then-back-up-again par-5 5th.
- Stephanie Davis picked up her first career SGL win in Flight 4 at Los Caballeros
- The island green 15th hole at Wigwam, usually difficult because of a wickedly left-to-right sloping green, yielded five Deuces.
