Tournament Recap-Orange Tree, Ringers Round 2

What is likely a record 67 SGL golfers turned up last Saturday at Orange Tree for the second round of the 2020-21 Ringers event. The course is playing tougher than it's 119 slope rating, as evidenced by a field average gross of 92.6 and net of 79.6. Amy Arnold was the day's medalist with a solid 75, and she doubled up and posted the low net as well at 68.

The birdie rate was well below league average, as despite the large number of players there were just 34 of them, coming from 24 players on only 11 of the holes. Elmer Schmidt made four of them, two more than anyone else. Mike Tobin had two of the zero-putt variety.

As will likely be the case throughout Ringers, the hardest hole was the well-guarded par-4 18th, playing at +1.84 strokes overpar, and the easiest was the short, straight-ahead par-5 6th at +0.63. That hole alone yielded nine of the birdies. Those averages are nearly identical to the last Orange Tree round.

Amy obviously won Flight 1. Flight 2 went to Michael Broudy with an 81 gross/73 net. Joe Pilewicz broke Ben Goodwin's three-event winning streak in Flight 3 at 81/70. Robert Johnson topped Flight 4 at 92/72 and Chad Cook bested another crowded Callaway Flight with 85/73.

Ben came close to matching Steve Hulka's recent 15th hole ace, but settled for a CTP inside 2 feet. The other CTPs went to Ken Slagle on the 4th hole, Steve on the 7th and Marty Skrobis on #12.

Ben and Ken converted theirs for Deuces, while Amy had a pair of them and Mike Tobin, Ron Sweat and Bryan Nelson also got to write a 2 on their cards.

It's no surprise that with all the birdies, Elmer grabbed a share of the Low Putts prize, tying with Michael Broudy at 29.

Joe collected earnings in Net Flights, Low Putts and Gross and Net Skins to top the day's money list at \$96.
