

Tournament Recap—SunRidge Canyon

Thirty-one SGL golfers took on the elevation changes and arroyos of SunRidge Canyon on Saturday and performed very well. The field's average gross was 89.1 and average net was 75.9. We had a tie for medalist at 76 between Elmer Schmidt and Bo Montgomery, while Ben Goodwin posted the low net at 67.

For the fifth straight event there was an above average birdie rate. Twenty-five were scored by 18 players on 11 holes. Elmer led the way with four, all part of a stellar 2-under 34 on the front nine.

The hardest hole proved to be the diagonally-bisected par-4 11th, playing to an average of 1.57 strokes over-par, while the easiest was the par-3 14th, which apparently plays much easier from Saturday's tee box than the one above it. The field average there was +0.60.

Elmer's 76 netted to 71 and earned him the Flight 1 win. Ben's net 67 was off a gross of 79 to lead Flight 2. June Vutrano shot 86/70 to win Flight 3, and Rich Pilewicz posted 86/68 to top Flight 4. Wiley Davis took honors in a small Callaway Flight with 83/71.

There were five CTPs up for grabs and they went to John Wilhelm on the 6th, Marc Caporrino on the 8th, Ben on the 12th, Dave Dean on the 14th and Randy Ross on #17. None of those were converted to Deuces; however, Ben made one instead on the 14th, as did June. Michael Urman posted a 2 on #8.

Greg Hileman used the fewest putts in the round with 29, while four others had 30.

Ben topped the list of 20 money winners with \$74.
